 - 2nd large group anti-racism training took place
 - Anti racism affinity groups begun
 - <u>IDE Steering Committee</u> working on focus groups with different constituencies that will be led by Cambridge Hill Partners, the outside firm that is assisting the steering committee.
 - IDE is trying to distinguish itself as different from the Anti-Racism training. Their primary goal is to create a clear vision of where the College needs to go in the next 10 years.
 - LIFG subcommittee was tasked to look into how the international students fit within this subgroup of students.

- Some international students are not first-gen but can have a similar experience to the first-gen situation due to not having familiary with U.S. higher education system.
- About 25% of international students are low-income although the threshold is different than domestic students.
