

Summer Liberal Arts Institute (SLAI) Computer Science Teaching Assistant PD

Position Title: Virtual Teaching Assistant (TA) for the Carleton SLAI Computer Science Program

Who should apply?

This position is open to current Carleton Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors. The Computer Science Program is an online three-week residential summer institute that gives current high school sophomores and juniors a change to experience college level work in computer science. The Computer Science Program offers five guided research groups; Teaching Assistants will assist one guided research group for the duration of SLAI. TAs will assist faculty with class activities, working closely with participants as they learn to identify and use systematic problem solving skills employed by computer scientists while completing a collaborative guided research project.

Position Schedule:

- This position will run from July 5th - 30th as an hourly student work position.
- The hourly pay rate will be \$11.25/hour.
- The maximum weekly hours for this position will be 40, and the average hours will sit between 25-30.
- This is a remote position, and most hours will fall between 8am - 5pm CST. Some evening work may be required, and the weekly time commitment will depend on the program faculty director.

Qualifications and Requirements:

This position is open to current Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors.

- Applicants must have an interest in working with high school juniors and seniors and possess the ability to help and mentor the students.
- Applicants should model appropriate behavior and time management skills.

Desired Qualifications:

- Prior experience working with Middle or High School students.
- Experience with at least one of the five computing research topics being covered within the institute.
- A passion for Carleton and what we can offer each individual student.
- Past experiences at Camps or Pre-college programs.

Responsibilities:

This position primarily supports the academic success of high school students participating in online pre-college programs by directly assisting a SLAI faculty instructor within a specific program.

Job responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:

- Reading all the assigned student materials
- Serving as a source of academic information for program participants
- Checking daily attendance
- Maintaining virtual office hours for program participant support
- Creating and implementing lesson plans
- Running small group discussions
- Helping students navigate Carleton's online learning resources
