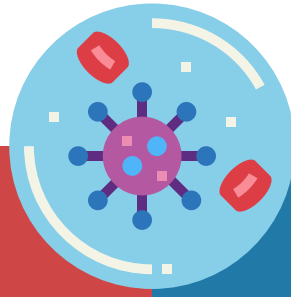


STI Myths



STI Facts

STIs are pretty rare.

1 in 2 sexually active people will get an STI by the age of 25.

I don't have to use protection for oral or anal sex.

Almost all STIs that can be spread via condomless vaginal sex can also be spread through condomless oral and anal sex.

All STIs are incurable.

All STIs, even HIV, are treatable, and most are curable.

I only need to get tested if I think I have an STI.

Many STIs have no signs or symptoms.

If you've had condomless sex, have a new partner or multiple partners, or for any reason are worried you have been exposed to an STI, talk with a healthcare provider about getting tested.
