## 2021-2022 Verification Worksheet for Federal Student Aid Programs

The federal government selected your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for review in a process called "Verification". In this process the law requires Carleton to compare information from your 2021–2022 FAFSA application with the 2019 federal tax records, W-2 forms, or other financial documents before awarding Federal Student Aid. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected.

You and at least one parent that was listed on the FAFSA, must complete and sign this *Verification Worksheet*, attach any required documents, and submit to our office within two weeks so that your aid won't be delayed. We are unable to award you federal aid until verification is complete. ## **Family Information**
