

  - Web-only, with multiple follow-ups
  - Survey instrument shared by 31 similar institutions
- Overall Response Rate 36% (8,248 of 22,808)
  - Female rate 38% Male rate 35%
  - "Graduated" rate 42% "Did not graduate" rate 10%
