1. Passport <i>New US Passport costs \$145, adult renewals are \$110.</i>	\$ 0 - \$ 145
2. Visa <i>India – six-month multiple entry</i>	\$ 125
3. Travel to/from program site <i>Round-trip travel to London</i>	\$ 1,000 - \$1,200
4. Additional required program travel <i>Meals in London during orientation – 3 lunches, 2 dinners</i>	\$ 120
5. Textbooks	\$ 100
6. Required apparel and gear <i>None</i>	\$ 0
7. Cell phone <i>Students must either purchase a SIM card for their unlocked smartphone or a local phone in India. The cost of data, texting, and minutes will vary based on use and specific plan. This estimate is for purchase of a local phone with SIM card, text and calling.</i>	\$ 75 - \$ 100
8. Personal expenses <i>Incidental medical expenses, materials for Independent Study Project.</i>	\$ 500 - \$ 700
9. International Student ID Card (optional) <i>Not required, but available for \$25 from at https://www.isic.org/. Provides international recognition as a student, some insurance, and discounts in some countries.</i>	\$ 25
10. Medical Travel Consultation <i>Often covered by your personal health insurance, but check with your insurance provider for details.</i>	
11. Immunizations and Anti-Malarial Medication <i>Portions of these costs are often covered by your personal health insurance, but check your insurance policy for details.</i>	\$ 0 - \$ 1350
12. Travel insurance (optional) <i>Covers airfare cancellation and lost or stolen baggage.</i>	
13. Personal property insurance (optional) <i>Covers some electronics, jewelry, personal items. Learn more here: https://apps.carleton.edu/curricular/ocs/travel/travelins/.</i>
