**Carleton College Academic Credits**

Transcripts for Carleton Global Engagement programs are issued using Carleton credit units. According to [Carleton College Academic Regulations and Procedures](#), "the standard Carleton course is six credits; for purposes of transfer evaluation, six Carleton credits are comparable to three and one-third (3 1/3) semester credits or five quarter credits."

Students participating in a Carleton Global Engagement program are registered for courses totaling 32 Carleton College credits. Carleton College recommends the following conversion between Carleton credits and semester credits. Students should contact the study abroad office or registrar's office at their home institution for institution-specific transfer credit policies

<b>1. Passport</b> <i>New US Passport costs \$145, adult renewals are \$110.</i>	<b>\$ 0 - \$ 145</b>
<b>2. Visa</b> <i>This is program is under 90 days, so a Schengen visa is not required for U.S. passport holders. Students carrying passports from other countries should consult with Carleton Off-Campus Studies Office.</i>	<b>\$ 0</b>
<b>3. Travel to/from program site</b> <i>Round-trip to Europe</i>	<b>\$ 1,000 - \$ 1,300</b>
<b>4. Additional required program travel</b>	<b>\$ 0</b>
<b>5. Textbooks and course materials</b>	<b>\$ 150</b>
<b>6. Required gear</b> <i>None</i>	<b>\$ 0</b>
<b>7. Cell phone</b> <i>A SIM card for Sweden will be provided for students who bring an unlocked smartphone to Sweden. The cost of data, texting, and minutes will vary based on use and specific plan.</i>	<b>\$ 130 - \$ 170</b>
<b>8. Personal expenses</b> <i>Incidental medical expenses, materials for Independent Study Project</i>	<b>\$ 1,000 - \$ 1,400</b>
<b>9. International Student ID Card</b> <i>Required. Cost is covered by program fees for students on Women's and Gender Studies in Europe. Provides international recognition as a student, some insurance, and discounts in some countries.</i>	<b>Covered by Program Fees</b>
<b>10. Medical Travel Consultation</b> <i>Often covered by your personal health insurance, but check with your insurance provider for details.</i>	
<b>11. Immunizations</b> <i>Portions of these costs are often covered by your personal health insurance, but check your insurance policy for details.</i>	
<b>12. Travel insurance (optional)</b> <i>Covers airfare cancellation and lost or stolen baggage.</i>
