Transcripts for Carleton Global Engagement programs are issued using Carleton credit units. According to <u>Carleton College Academic Regulations and Procedures</u>, "the standard Carleton course is six credits; for purposes of transfer evaluation, six Carleton credits are comparable to three and one-third (3 1/3) semester credits or five quarter credits."

Students participating in a Carleton Global Engagement program are registered for courses totaling 32 Carleton College credits. Carleton College recommends the following conversion between Carleton credits and semester credits. Students should contact the study abroad office or registrar's office at their home institution for institution-specific transfer credit policies

8. Personal expenses Incidental medical expenses, materials for Independent Study Project	\$ 1,000 - \$ 1,400
9. Stockholm Travel Pass Cost is covered by program fees for students on Women's and Gender Studies in Europe. Provides access to public transportation around Stockholm to facilitate travel between student residences and classroom meeting spaces.	Covered by Program Fees
10. Medical Travel Consultation Often covered by your health insurance, but check with your insurance provider for details.	
11. Immunizations Portions of these costs are often covered by your health insurance, but check your insurance policy for details.	
12. Travel insurance (optional) Covers airfare cancellation and lost or stolen baggage.
