




## Off-campus studies participation trends

42 of the 48 religion majors in the classes of 2012-2016 (88%) participated in off-campus studies. Of these:

- 35 students (83%) did 1 OCS program, and 7 (17%) did 2 programs.
- 24 students (57%) went on Carleton program(s), and 24 (57%) went on non-Carleton program(s). 6 (14%) did both.
