Details of the Carleton Math Competition

The Carleton Math Competition is a non-profit student-organized annual event that engages high school students in challenging and novel mathematics. Students will participate in the competition as groups of up to six. Schools may send as many teams of students as they wish. All students will participate in individual and team rounds, and exceptional performances in both will be recognized at the end of the day.

Date: April 1st, 2017

Venue: Carleton College, Northfield MN

Duration: All day (Check-In is at 8:00am and the Award Ceremony ends at 4:30pm)

Cost: \$12 per attendee (students + coaches)

We will be running four different rounds: Power, Individual, Team, and Carleton Special.

Power Round

The Power Round will be distributed one week before the competition for teams to complete. It is a proof based round, focusing on a specific branch of mathematics.

Individual Round

In the Individual Round each student will complete two individual tests from the following categories: algebra, geometry, number theory, combinatorics, sequences/series, and complex numbers. Each test will be 45 minutes.

Team Round

The Team Round is a hour long test that contains questions from an array of topics. Both the individual and team rounds will be done before lunch.

Carleton Special Round

This year, the Carleton Special Round will be a team round focused on problems in which students are expected to arrive at an approximate answer (e.g. the sum of all of the primes between 1 and 1,000,000). More points will be awarded for more accurate responses.

There will be a Math Talk given by one of Carleton's Faculty before the Awards Ceremony at the end of the day.

You will be responsible for finding lodging (if necessary) and transportation. We will provide lunch.
