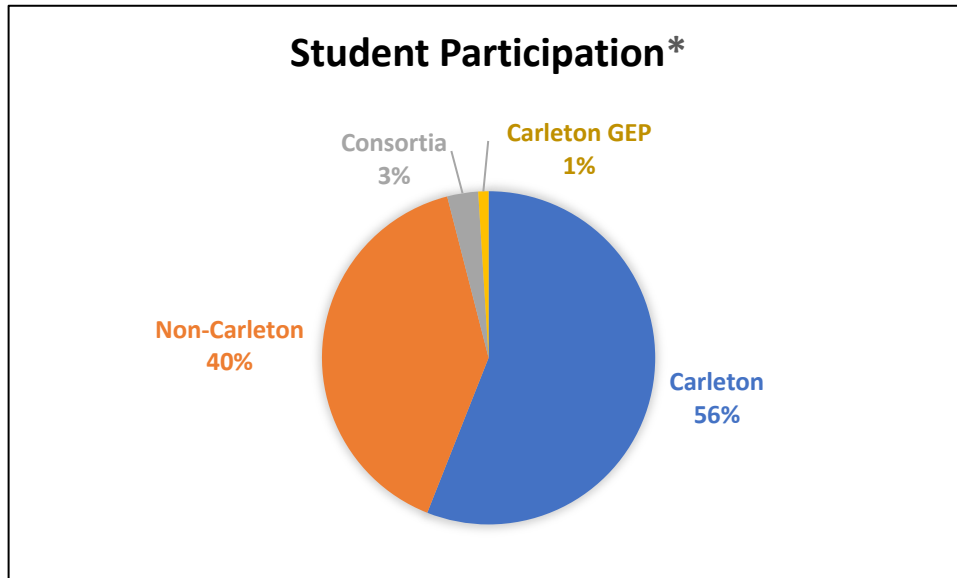

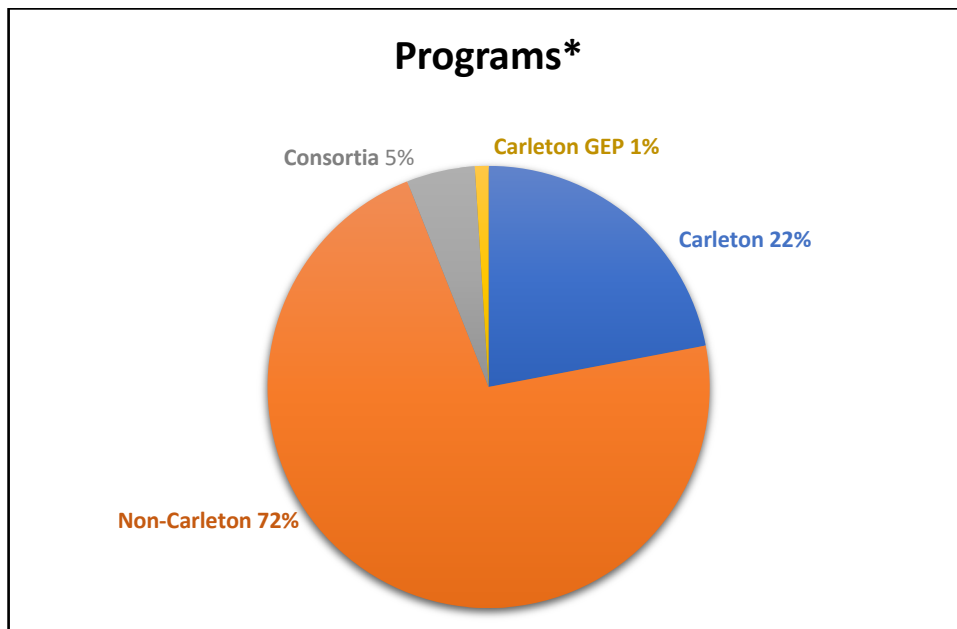

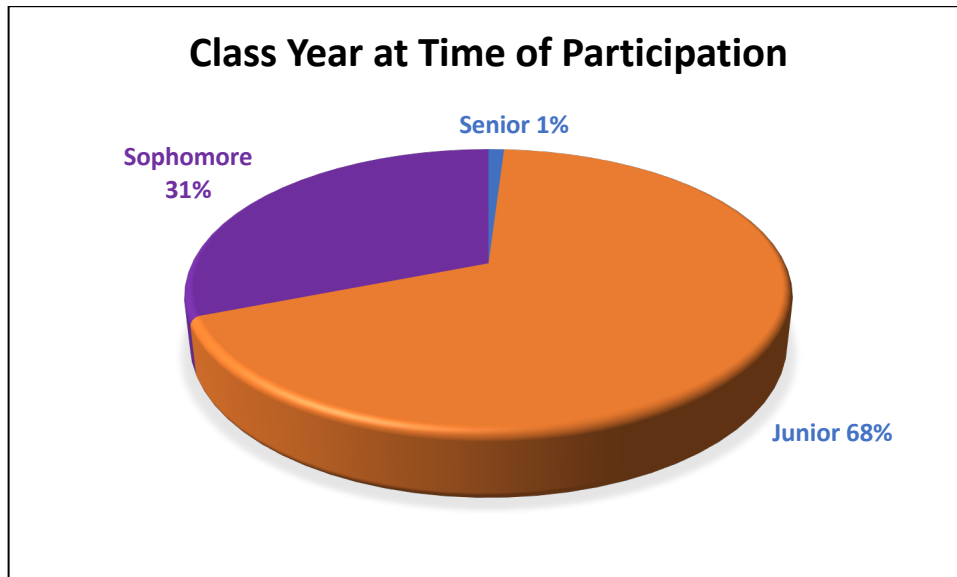
- 319 individuals participated 374 times in off-campus study programming during their four years or 12 terms
- 10 of these individuals participated in the spring break 2020 and the winter break 2020 programs that had their field trips cancelled due to the pandemic. There are a few spots where this total is used*, but for the most part, the report covers only those students who studied off-campus.



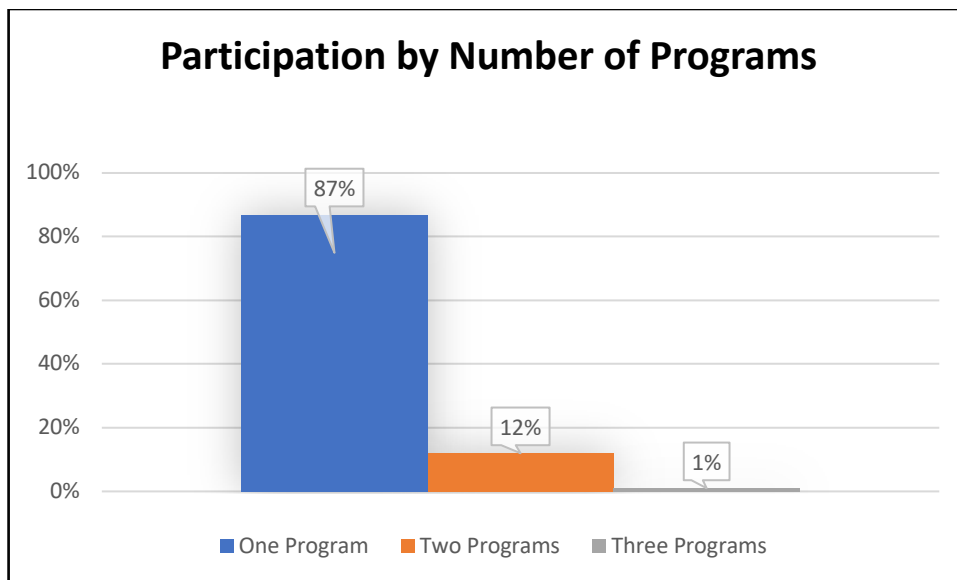
While the majority of students participated on Carleton programs, the majority of programs students participated on were non-Carleton. A total of 120 programs, three of which were the online spring break 2020 and the winter break 20 programs.

Participation by Legal Sex

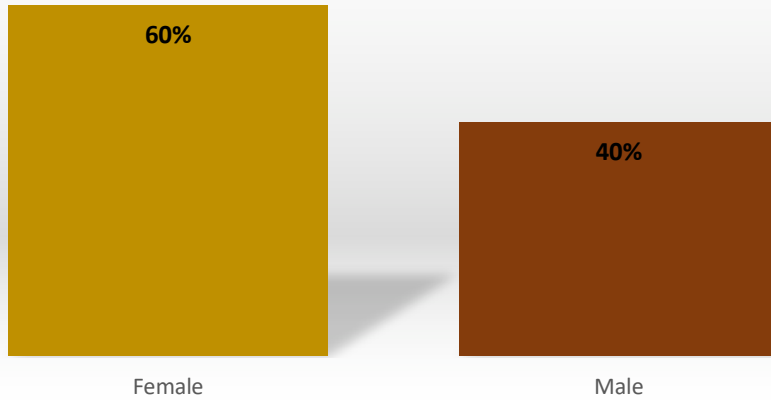
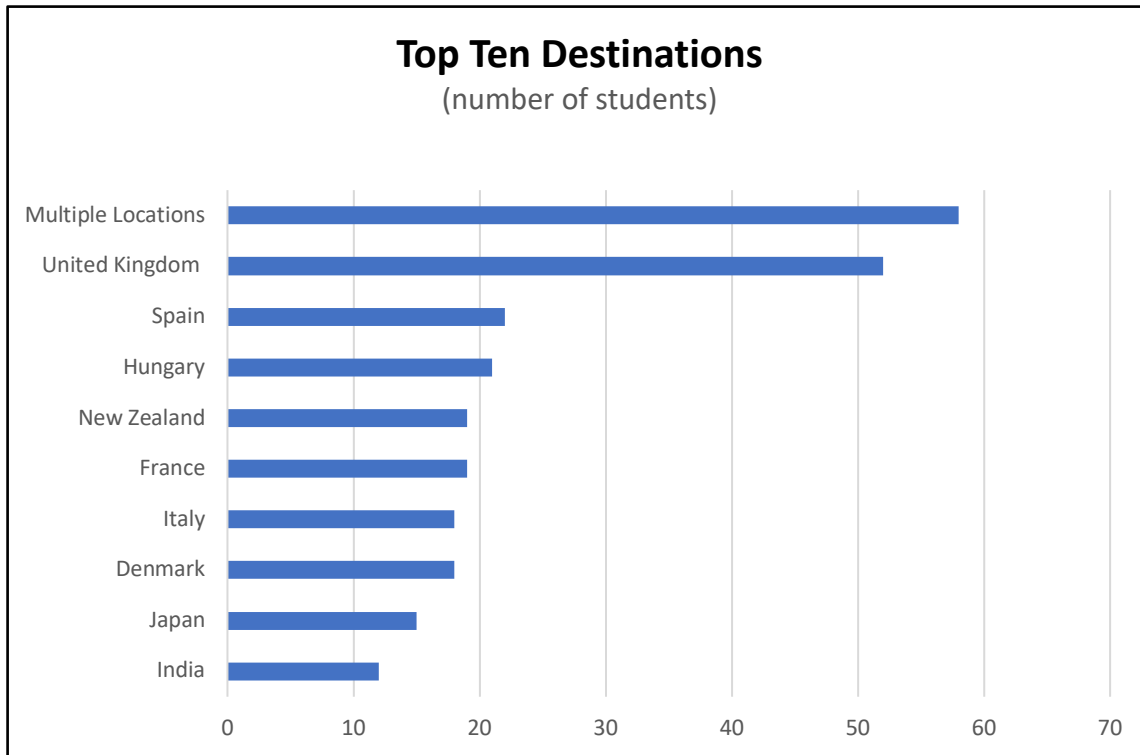

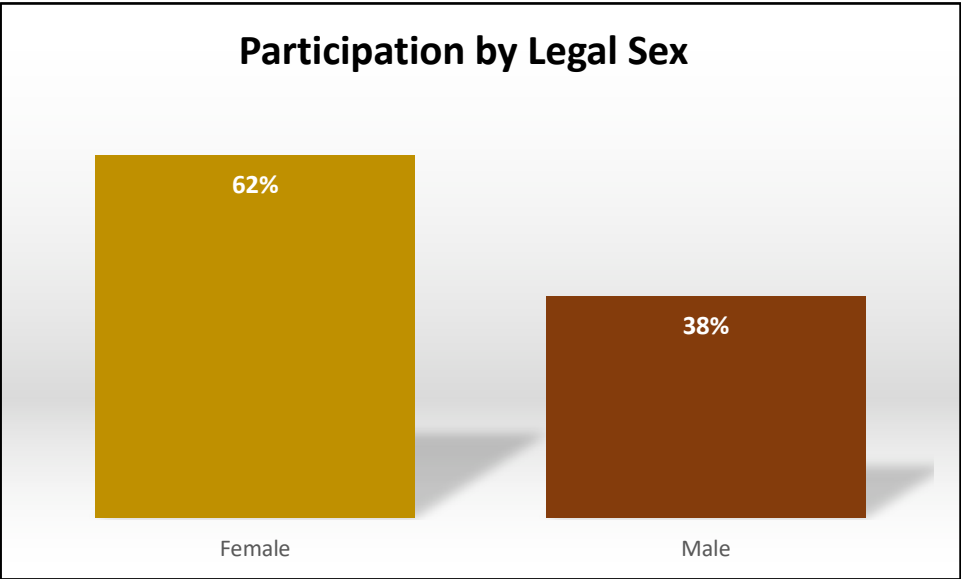
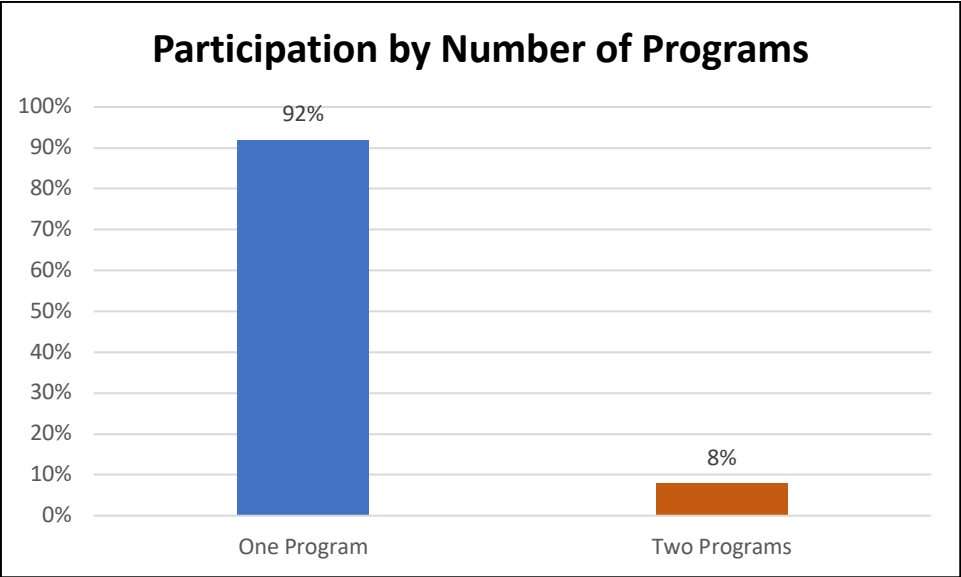
Academic Year 2020-21

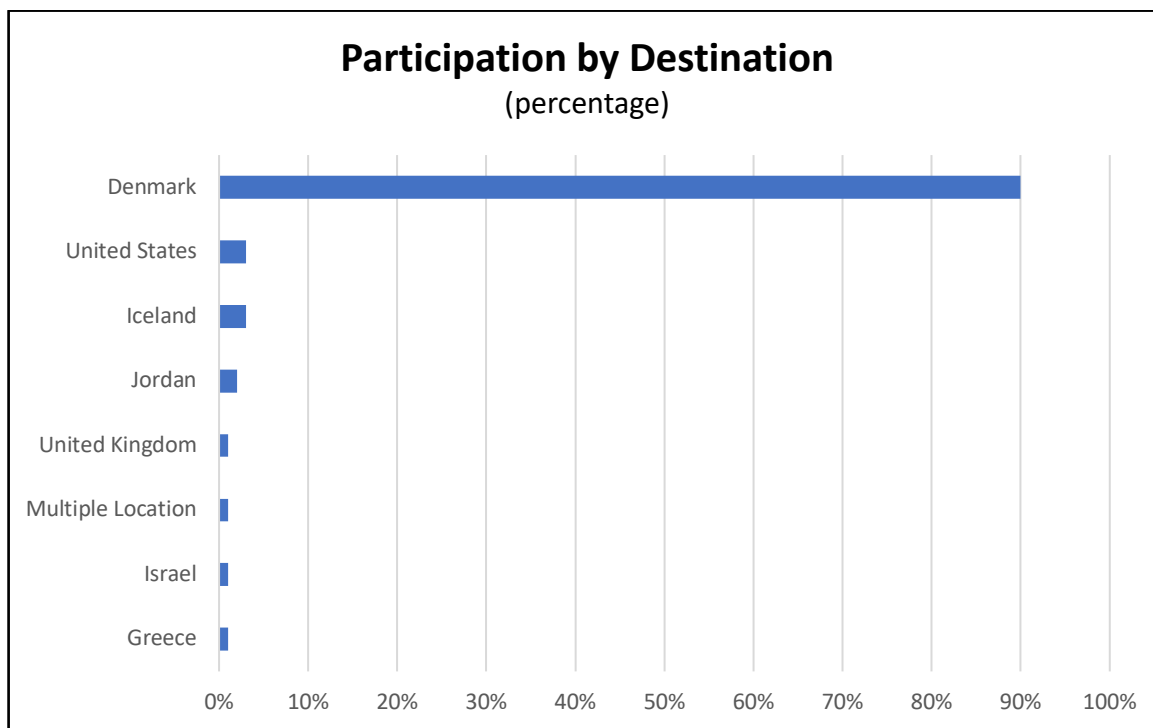
Between June 2020 and July 2021:

- Carleton officially enrolled 1918 degree-seeking students
- 106 students, about 6% of the student body, participated in on-site off-campus study programs 115 times for academic credit during the pandemic year
- 103 students earned off-campus study credit outside the United States
- Students studied off-campus on 11 different programs in 9 countries and territories

All Carleton programs for 2020-21 were cancelled. Carleton worked with DIS Study Abroad in Scandinavia to create fall term and winter term programs specifically for Carleton students. 89% of the onsite participants participated in this special programming.
